DECISION AND DIRECTION

November 28, 1990

The National Labor Relations Board, by a three-member panel, has considered determinative challenges in an election held June 1, 1990, and the hearing officer's report recommending disposition of them. The election was conducted pursuant to a Stipulated Election Agreement. The tally of ballots shows 15 for and 13 against the Petitioner, with 4 challenged ballots.

The Board has reviewed the record in light of the exceptions and briefs, and has adopted the hearing officer's findings and recommendations.¹

DIRECTION

It is directed that the Regional Director for Region 19 shall, within 14 days from the date of this Decision and Direction, open and count the ballots of Gene Cheeseman and Billy Cheeseman. The Regional Director shall then serve on the parties a revised tally of ballots and issue the appropriate certification.
