Dear Ms. Selman:

The above-captioned case, petitioning for an investigation and decertification of representative under Section 9(c) of the National Labor Relations Act, has been carefully investigated and considered.

As a result of the investigation, it appears that further proceedings are not warranted at this time. On May 4, 1990, you filed the instant petition seeking an election among certain of the Employer's employees. On May 4, 1990, the Region blocked the petition pending the processing of an unfair labor practice charge filed against the Employer in Case No. 16-CA-14245-2 and 16-CA-14327. The charges went before the Board and were ruled upon on November 10, 1992. On February 2, 1998, the Employer satisfactorily complied with the affirmative requirements of the resulting Board Order and the cases were closed. Since that time, and despite several attempts to contact you, this office has not been able to locate you because the telephone number and mailing address you provided when you filed the petition are no longer correct. This office has also been informed that Employer is no longer conducting business in the state of Texas and the Local Union representing the bargaining unit employees no longer exists.

Accordingly, I am dismissing the petition based on your failure to cooperate in the processing of the petition. A review of this action may be obtained by filing an appeal with the National Labor Relations Board, Washington, D.C. 20570 by close of business on June 22, 2004. See attached Form NLRB-4916 as to instructions for filing such request for review.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING REQUEST FOR REVIEW OF

ADMINISTRATIVE DISMISSAL OF REPRESENTATION PETITION

Pursuant to the National Labor Relations Board Rules and Regulations, Series 8, as amended, you may obtain a review of this action by filing a request therefor with the National Labor Relations Board, addressed to the Executive Secretary, National Labor Relations Board, 1099 14th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20570. A copy of such request for review must be served on the Regional Director and each of the other parties to the proceeding. This request for review must contain a complete statement setting forth the facts and reasons upon which it is based. The request for review (*eight copies*) must be received by the Executive Secretary of the Board in Washington, D.C., by the close of business on **June 22, 2004**. Upon good cause shown, however, the Board may grant special permission for a longer period within which to file. The request for extension of time should be submitted to the Executive Secretary of the Board in Washington, D.C., and a copy of any such request for extension of time should be submitted to the Regional Director, and to each of the other parties to this proceeding.

The request for review and any request for extension of time for filing must include a statement that a copy has been served on the Regional Director and on each of the other parties to this proceeding, and a **copy must be served** in the same or faster manner as that utilized in filing the request with the Board. When filing with the Board is accomplished by personal service, however, the other parties shall be promptly notified of such action by telephone, followed by service of a copy by mail or telegraph.
