ORDER TRANSFERRING CASES PURSUANT TO
TEMPORARY INTERREGIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The General Counsel of the National Labor Relations Board having duly considered the matter, deeming it necessary in order to effectuate the purposes of the National Labor Relations Act, and to avoid unnecessary costs or delay,

HEREBY ORDERS that for the period from October 1, 2008, through January 31, 2009, from time to time, cases filed in **Region 1** will be transferred to **Region 22**; cases filed in **Region 4** will be transferred to **Region 6**; cases filed in **Region 15** will be transferred to **Region 3** and **Region 12**; cases filed in **Region 16** will be transferred to **Region 17**; cases filed in **Region 21** will be transferred to **Region 25**; cases filed in **Region 30** will be transferred to **Region 7**; and cases filed in **Region 34** will be transferred to **Region 3**.

These cases will automatically transfer back to the Regions in which they originated and processing of these cases will continue in those Regions, to the extent necessary, upon the earliest of the following: issuance of a letter by the Regional Director of the transferee Region deferring further proceedings on the charge pursuant to the Board's *Collyer/Dubo* policy, completion of the investigation with recommendations for further processing in the originating Region, or closing of the case.
