**GAYE NELL HYMON IS APPOINTED DEPUTY REGIONAL ATTORNEY  
IN NLRB'S ATLANTA, GA REGIONAL OFFICE**

National Labor Relations Board's General Counsel Ronald Meisburg announced the appointment of career attorney Gaye Nell Hymon as Deputy Regional Attorney in the Agency's Regional Office in Atlanta, GA (Region 10). In her new position, Ms. Hymon will assist Regional Director Martin Arlook in the enforcement of the National Labor Relations Act in Georgia, North Central Alabama, and Eastern Tennessee.

The NLRB investigates and remedies unfair labor practices and conducts secret-ballot elections to determine whether employees desire union representation.

Commenting on the appointment, General Counsel Meisburg stated:

Gaye Nell Hymon is a talented and dedicated public servant who brings exceptional skills and experience to her new position. Her promotion helps ensure that the high quality work of the Atlanta Regional Office will continue. I am very pleased that she is joining the Region's management team as Deputy Regional Attorney.
