**NLRB HOUSTON, TX RESIDENT OFFICE TO REMAIN CLOSED
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 22 BECAUSE OF HURRICANE IKE**

National Labor Relations Board General Counsel Ronald Meisburg announced today that the Board's Houston, TX Resident Office (Region 16) will remain closed Monday, September 22, as the Mickey Leland Federal Office Building, in which the Resident Office is located, continues to undergo mitigation of damage resulting from Hurricane Ike. The General Services Administration currently plans to reopen the building on Tuesday, September 23, but this plan is subject to change.

General Counsel Meisburg advises employers, unions, and individuals served by the Houston Resident Office to contact the Board's Fort Worth, TX Regional Office (Region 16) for the duration of the Houston Office's temporary closure. The staff of the Houston and Fort Worth Offices will continue to work with parties with respect to the status of any hearings or elections that are scheduled to be held this week.
