Gentlemen:

After careful consideration of this matter and in accordance with established Board policy, the undersigned has decided to hold further processing of the above-captioned representation case in abeyance until such time as the merits of Case **GR-7-CA-50105** have been determined. If the allegations are true, until remedied, they could affect the free choice of employees in an election, were one to be held. Carson Pirie Scott and Company, 69 NLRB 935, 938, 939; J.C. Penny Company (Store # 134), 162 NLRB 1553, 1555, Fn. 3; Henry Colder Company, 163 NLRB 105, 109, Fn. 11.

Pursuant to the National Labor Relations Board's Rules and Regulations, Series 8, as amended, any party may obtain a review of this action by filing a request for review with the National Labor Relations Board, Executive Secretary, 1099 14<sup>th</sup> Street, NW, Washington D.C. 20570. A copy of the request for review must be served on each of the other parties to the proceeding, as well as the undersigned. This request for review must contain a complete statement setting forth the facts and reasons on which it is based. The request for review (eight copies) should be filed with the Board by close of business on **Friday, January 25, 2007**, except

that the Board may, upon good cause shown, grant special permission for a longer period within which to file. The request for review **MAY NOT** be filed by facsimile transmission. A request for extension of time, which **MAY** be filed by facsimile transmission, should be submitted to the Board in Washington no later than the date set forth above for filing of the request for review, and a copy of any such request for extension of time should be submitted to the undersigned and to the other parties to this proceeding.

In the Regional Office's initial correspondence, the parties were advised that the National Labor Relations Board has expanded the list of permissible documents that may be electronically filed with its offices. If a party wishes to file one of the documents which may now be filed electronically, please refer to the Attachment supplied with the Regional Office's initial correspondence for guidance in doing so. Guidance for E-filing can also be found on the National Labor Relations Board web site at [www.nlrb.gov](http://www.nlrb.gov). On the home page of the website, select the **E-Gov** tab and click on **E-Filing**. Then select the NLRB office for which you wish to E-File your documents. Detailed E-filing instructions explaining how to file the documents electronically will be displayed.

The request for review and any request for extension of time must include a statement that a copy has been served on me and on each of the other parties to this proceeding in the same or a faster manner as that utilized in filing the request with the Board.
