## N.L.R.B. ELECTION REPORT

### CASES CLOSED APRIL 2003

NOTE: This monthly report lists the outcome of secret-ballot voting by employees in NLRB-conducted representation elections as officially certified following resolution of postelection objections and/or challenges. Inquiries regarding the contents of this report should be directed to the Division of Information, National Labor Relations Board, 1099 14th St., N.W., Washington, D.C. 20570. This publication is distributed monthly on a subscription basis by the Government Printing Office. During FY 2003, the NLRB continued to improve its techniques for tracking and collecting case activity data. While significant efforts were made to verify the accuracy of the FY 2003 data, some inconsistencies can be found between some tables in these reports and in comparing data in the ER and Annual Report. Data fields on "AFL-CIO" elections in the FY 2002 and FY 2003 annual reports inadvertently include elections involving the Carpenters Union, which disaffiliated with the AFL-CIO in March 2001.

### Explanatory Note

Election Report data is derived from the National Labor Relations Board's Case Activity Tracking System (CATS). The Agency has an active program to ensure a high level of accuracy in the collection and dissemination of case-related information. However, monthly election data describes dynamic case activity that is subject to revision and correction during the course of the year and all data should be interpreted with that understanding. Users who have questions about the accuracy of information relating to specific elections reflected in the report are advised to call the Regional Office where the election was conducted for clarification and to report errors.
