Subject: DATA Act (OIG-AMR-95)

This is to advise you that the Office of Inspector General (OIG) is initiating the subject audit. The objectives of this audit are to:

- Evaluate whether the National Labor Relations Board's internal controls over spending data have been properly designed, implemented, and operating effectively to manage and report financial and award data in accordance with the DATA Act;
- Assess the completeness, timeliness, quality, and accuracy of the National Labor Relations Board's Fiscal Year 2021, first quarter financial award data submitted for publication on USASpending.gov; and
- Assess the National Labor Relations Board's implementation and use of the Governmentwide financial data standards established by the Office of Management and Budget and Treasury.

We will begin this audit with an entrance conference on March 1, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. via Microsoft Teams. Field work is scheduled to be completed in June, and a draft report is scheduled to be issued in July 2021.
