This is to advise you that the Office of Inspector General (OIG) is initiating the subject audit. The objectives of this audit are:

- Determine whether the Headquarters personnel requirement estimates, used for the annual budget submission, are developed and calculated in accordance with Governmentwide guidance;
- Evaluate the Headquarters staffing levels and workload trends; and
- Evaluate the internal controls over the Headquarters personnel requirement estimates used for the annual budget submission.

The scope of this audit is:

- To determine compliance with Governmentwide guidance and evaluate internal controls, the scope is Headquarters personnel requirement estimates used for the FY 2025 budget submission; and
- To evaluate the Headquarters staffing levels and workload trends, the scope is FY 2022 and FY 2023.

We will begin this audit with an entrance conference that will take place February 12, 2024, at 3 pm via Microsoft Teams. Field work is scheduled to be completed in May 2024, and a draft report is scheduled to be issued in June 2024.
