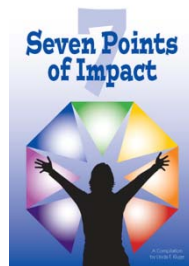
Three authors will discuss their personal journeys from overcoming personal obstacles to living their dreams.
