

During negotiations on January 24, 2019, the Employer provided the Union with a comprehensive set of proposals. On February 1, 2019, the Union summarily rejected all of the substantive proposals without explanation. Among other things, the Union summarily rejected an Employer proposal to discuss certain terms and conditions of employment. A refusal to even discuss certain terms and conditions of employment is a refusal to bargain.


During negotiations on February 28, 2019, the Union threatened to refuse to bargain over any of more than 20 open issues until the Employer agreed to a change in its proposal on wages.


