Within the last six months the above named union filed a lawsuit in Federal Court to try to coerce the Employer into an interest arbitration when the parties are in negotiations to for a collective bargaining agreement. The Union is bargaining in bad faith by trying to circumvent the bargaining process to coerce the Employer into an agreement that it not in the best interests of the Employer. Further, the Union is bargaining in bad faith by trying to use an expired Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) in February 1, 2018 to coerce the Employer into an interest arbitration. Since the MOA is expired the Union is precluded from using this MOA. Further, the Union is bargaining in bad faith by stating they will never accept the provision in the Employer's proposals. In fact, the Union stated in negotiations they will only accept the provisions in a Master Agreement they have negotiated. In addition, the Employer contends the Union is violating the principals in Bill Johnson in filing a lawsuit that is without merit and is retaliatory. Thus, the Employer is seeking 10j relief to bar said lawsuit.
