(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) has also coerced mgmt. of the need to repost my bid on the basis that I am unassigned and my bid is not in the computer system. Instead of helping me update my bid status, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) wants me to be removed from my bid assignment for personal reasons, thereby, resulting in having the status of my bid description changed. It became evident last Oct. 3, 2018 when (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told me (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) will post my bid because of the Union. There has been no assistance from APWU to resolve my issue; the Union, and its representatives, is not acting in good faith in providing fair representation for me nor protecting my rights.
