1. Charging Party and many similarly situated discriminatees are employed by Lamb Weston in Louisiana, within a bargaining unit represented by UFCW Local 455. This UFCW union and Lamb Weston have been parties to collective bargaining agreements in the past.

2. Since about June 2017 and within the past six months and continuing to date, there has existed a contractual "hiatus" in this bargaining unit, in which no collective bargaining agreement was in effect.

3. During the contractual hiatus period, in May 2018, Charging Party (and other similarly situated discriminatees) submitted to UFCW Local 455 and the employer letters resigning from union membership and revoking their dues authorizations.

4. UFCW Local 455 has willfully failed and refused to accept these revocations of the dues authorizations, and continues to demand and retain dues collected by Lamb Weston from these employees' salaries, including the Charging Party's salary.

5. UFCW Local 455 has never responded to the employees' letters, refusing to acknowledge them and refusing to provide the employees with a copy of the dues authorization cards they signed despite a direct request for them.

6. Similarly, and at the behest of the union, Lamb Weston continues to deduct dues from the salaries of the Charging Party and similarly situated employees who submitted check off revocation letters during the hiatus period, and pay those unlawfully seized dues to the union.

7. These and related acts and omissions restrain and coerce the Charging Party and others similarly situated in the exercise of their § 7 rights to refrain from collective activity, violate the DFR, and discriminate based upon the employees' nonunion status. By these acts, the union is also receiving and accepting unlawful support and assistance from an employer.

3. During the contractual hiatus period, in May 2018, Charging Party (and other similarly situated discriminatees) submitted to UFCW Local 455 and the employer letters resigning from union membership and revoking their dues authorizations.

4. UFCW Local 455 has willfully failed and refused to accept these revocations of the dues authorizations, and continues to demand and retain dues collected by Lamb Weston from these employees' salaries, including the Charging Party's salary.

5. UFCW Local 455 has never responded to the employees' letters, refusing to acknowledge them and refusing to provide the employees with a copy of the dues authorization cards they signed despite a direct request for them.

6. Similarly, and at the behest of the union, Lamb Weston continues to deduct dues from the salaries of the Charging Party and similarly situated employees who submitted check off revocation letters during the hiatus period, and pay those unlawfully seized dues to the union.

7. These and related acts and omissions restrain and coerce the Charging Party and others similarly situated in the exercise of their § 7 rights to refrain from collective activity, violate the DFR, and discriminate based upon the employees' nonunion status. By these acts, the union is also receiving and accepting unlawful support and assistance from an employer.
