Since on or about a date in the last six months, the Highway Road & Street Construction Laborers Local Union 1010, LIUNA ("Local 1010") has threatened, coerced and restrained Consolidated Edison of New York ("Con Ed") and other persons engaged in commerce with an object of forcing or requiring Con Ed to enter into an agreement which is prohibited by Section 8(e).

Since on or about a date in the last six months, Local 1010 has threatened, coerced and restrained Con Ed and other persons engaged in commerce with an object of forcing or requiring Con Ed to cease doing business with contractors and/or subcontractors that have collective-bargaining agreements with Construction Council Local 175, Utility Workers of America ("Local 175").

Since on or about a date in the last six months, Local 1010 has threatened, coerced and restrained Con Ed and other persons engaged in commerce with an object of forcing or requiring Con Edison and/or its contractors and/or its subcontractors to recognize and bargain with Local 1010 as the representative of its employees notwithstanding that such union has not been certified as the representative of such employees under the provisions of Section 9.
