

Since on or about October 10, 2019, Transport Workers Union of America, AFL-CIO, Local 264 (the "Union") has refused to furnish information requested by the Employer that is relevant to the parties' negotiations for a successor contract. Specifically, the Union, through its (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), informed the Employer over the course of two bargaining sessions that the Union's bargaining representatives were not authorized to respond to the Employer's proposals or to make proposals on behalf of the Union, and that the team would not meet again with the Employer as a result of actions taken by the Employer that they alleged interfered with the Union's ability to take actions required of them by the Union's Constitution and Bylaws.

On October 4, 2019, the Employer requested the Union provide the Employer with

(1) a copy of the Union's Bylaws and Constitution for both Local 264 and the Transport Workers Union of America, also known as the International Union;

(2) a list of each and every provision of the Union's Bylaws and Constitution (for both the Local and the International) the Union claims it and/or its elected officials have not been able to comply with as a result of actions taken by the Employer; and

(3) a brief description of how the Employer's actions have rendered the Union and/or its elected officials unable to comply with each of the provisions identified in response to request number 2 above.

In its response on October 12, 2019, the Union

(1) refused to provide the Constitution and Bylaws because the Union did "not see the relevance of this request as it does not relate to any of the College proposals and furthermore, we deem this proposal as intrusive;"

(2) provided information responsive to the Employer's request number 2; and

(3) refused to provide information requested in request number 3, stating that the Union's response to request number 2 "speaks for themselves and does not need further explanation."
