

## ATTACHMENT 1

1. L&W Supply, Inc., doing business as Stocking Specialist, Inc., ("Employer") is party to a collective bargaining agreement with the Northeast Regional Council of Carpenters of the United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners of America ("Charged Party").

2. The Employer is also party to a collective bargaining agreement with the International Union of Operating Engineers Local 825 ("Local 825").

3. On or about December 19, 2018, Local 825 filed a grievance against the Employer claiming that a non-bargaining unit employee was performing work that should be assigned to bargaining unit members of Local 825, such as the operation of a boom truck, in violation of the collective bargaining agreement. As a remedy, the grievance demanded that the Carpenter employee join Local 825.

4. The Employer has a history and practice of using mixed-composite crews, consisting of bargaining unit members of the Charged Party and Local 825. On these crews, members of both unions have a history of operating the boom and boom truck.

5. On or about December 27, 2018, the Charged Party threatened to picket and/or strike the Employer in support of its demand for continued assignment of certain work, including the operation of the boom and boom truck.

6. This is in violation of Section 8(b)(4)(ii)(D) of the Act.

7. Therefore, the Employer asserts that a jurisdictional dispute exists and requests that the Board initiate a 10(k) proceeding to resolve the dispute.
